This is to announce the 2015 Scholarship Program competition sponsored by the International Brotherhood of Boilermakers. In 2015, the Boilermakers will award a total of \$50,000 in scholarships with \$38,000 to be designated to United States students and \$12,000 to be designated to Canadian students.

To be eligible, the applicant must be a son, daughter, legally adopted child or dependent of a member in good standing. Applications are limited to high school seniors who will be entering their first year of academic study at a degree-granting, accredited college or university within one year of their high school graduation.

Applications will be accepted between January 1 and March 1, 2015. <u>Applications postmarked after the March 1, 2015 deadline cannot be considered.</u>

Scholarship candidates must submit the following:

- 1. The official Scholarship Application (as revised December, 2014);
- 2. proof of relationship or dependency to the Boilermaker member;
- 3. the results from their SAT and/or ACT test (for U.S. citizens);
- 4. the applicant's high school transcript; and
- 5. a 350 word (minimum), typed essay on this year's topic:

 Discuss ways that unions could use social media to help organize new members and service current members.

The Scholarship Committee appointed to review applications and select the winners consists of retired International Vice President Edward Power (Committee Chairman), International Vice Presidents Lawrence McManamon and Joseph Maloney, retired International Vice President James Pressley, and General Counsel Michael Stapp. The winners will be selected on the basis of a variety of factors, including academic achievement, career goals, extracurricular activities, outside school activities, and the applicant's essay.

Please note that applications, and <u>all</u> supporting documents, <u>must be postmarked by March 1, 2015 or they will not be considered</u>. In addition, the scholarship applications and essays must be typed or legibly handwritten. If applications are not legible, they will not be considered.
